### Decisions of the Cabinet Member (arising from the previous meeting)

The Advisory Committee's recommendations made at its last meeting (on 20/9/11) were all agreed by the Cabinet Member, except for the matters detailed below.

## Minute (3) – TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES TO FACILITATE THE RE-ROUTING OF BUS 470 (Abbey & Lavender Fields Wards)

### **Cabinet Member Decisions**

- (i) Agree to the Advisory Committee recommendations (that the proposed scheme be not taken forward); and, in addition,
- (ii) Ask officers to investigate with TfL the feasibility of the current 470 route being extended by dint of buses turning from Morden Road into Lombard Road and, either to complete a circuit within the industrial estate exiting on Morden Road or to turn around within the industrial estate close to the junction with Windsor Avenue and exit at the entry point, with the establishment of associated bus stop(s) within the estate.

Minute (5) – PROPOSED W7 CPZ (Controlled Parking Zone) (THE DOWNS) - INFORMAL CONSULTION (Raynes Park & Hillside Wards)

#### **Cabinet Member Decision**
