On Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 at 1450hrs, Police conducted a Test Purchase Operation at Best One Mini Market. Two 15 year old children (Volunteer Police Cadets) entered the shop premises and successfully purchased a bottle of Desperado strong Lager. They were not challenged as to their age and were not asked for any form of identification.

Licensing Officer PC Stevens entered the premises and spoke to the Designated Premises Supervisor and Premises Licence Holder Mr Nithiyakumar THANGAVELAUTHAM. The DPS stated that he was the only member of staff present and that he had made the sale, thinking that the customer had looked over 18 years old.

A Fixed Penalty Notice was issued for the offence of Selling Alcohol to an individual under 18 contrary to Sec 146 Licencing Act 2003.

Mr Thangavelautham presented his full copy of the Premises Licence for inspection and was found to be in breach of an additional condition imposed, "A minimum of two staff to be on duty at all times that the store is open for the sale of alcohol".
