Replacement of Conditions:

Condition 3 of Annex 3:

Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal.

Condition 6 of Annex 3:

The premises will operate a "Challenge 25" policy whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 25 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age. The recommended forms of ID that will be accepted are passports, driving licences with a photograph, photographic military ID or proof of age cards bearing the ' PASS' mark hologram.

New Conditions to be added to Annex 3:

- 9. Suitable and sufficient signage advertising the "Challenge 25" policy will be displayed in prominent locations in the premises.
- 10. All staff will be trained to ask customers to leave quietly in the evening when necessary.
- 11. There shall be appropriate signage at the premises requesting customers to leave quietly.
- 12. Refusals of alcohol sales shall be recorded in a log and made available for inspection by an authorised officer of the council or police when requested.
