That Council notes with regret the missed opportunity to include reference in the Report to local businesses, the local economy, the plight of our high streets, or sporting provision across the borough, given the Report's stated purpose under para 1.2 is to "report on progress" on the Strategic Priority set by the current/former administration in its Business Plan "[t]o promote a dynamic, connected and inclusive community and economy with safe, vibrant high streets and jobs for our residents"; that Council further notes the role of community policing in building an inclusive community with safe, vibrant high streets; and that Council calls on Cabinet to commit to running an active campaign against any further attempts to close police stations in Merton, in light of the Mayor of London's closure of 44 police stations since 2016 and his recently published Police & Crime Plan, which commits to the disposal of further Metropolitan Police premises.
