Addendum to Council Report

<u>Item 13 – Review of Proportionality and changes to Membership of</u> Committees

Additional section to be added to the report:

- 1.1. Officers have carried out a review of proportionality and the proposed allocation of seats to committees calculated to reflect the change in the political composition of the Council. This is attached at Appendix A. It is proposed that the size of the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Panel increases in size from 10 seats to 11 and for Councillor Charles to be appointed as a member of the panel as an Independent Member. The increase in size ensures that there is no reduction to any political group's current representation on that panel. Appendices B-D also detail appointments to places on other committees and bodies for Council approval.
- 1.2 The proposed membership of the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Panel is attached at Appendix B and is for ratification by Council.
