1. Type of hearing and powers of the sub-committee

1.1 The sub-committee is required to determine the application by taking such of the steps set out below as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

1.2 In making their determination the sub-committee must have regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the licensing objectives, guidance issued by the Secretary of State and Merton's Licensing Policy.

1.3 Review of premises licence: s52

- (i) To modify the conditions of the licence
- (ii) To exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
- (iii) To remove the designated premises supervisor
- (iv) To suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
- (v) To revoke the licence.

2. Hearing papers

2.1 The applications, notices and representations for determination by the sub-committee are contained in the hearing bundles together with any relevant existing licence. This includes any documents which must be sent to any of the parties to the hearing under Regulation 7(2) and Schedule 3 of The Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005. 3. Legal advice to the sub-committee

3.1 A legal officer appointed by the Assistant Director of Corporate Governance and Head of Legal Services will attend the hearing to advise the sub-committee on statutory provision and legal matters.

4.1 This application is for a review of a premises licence sought by the Metropolitan Police on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance.
