On 26th March 2016 officers visited the store to ensure all alcohol had been removed in compliance with the suspension. Officers found that there was still alcohol on the shelves though it had been covered with a bin liner. Both the staff and the owner were spoken to and instructed to remove the alcohol. When officers reattended the next day it had indeed been removed from the shelves.

On 15th April 2016 officers again visited the store and found a group of 8-9 Tamil males stood outside. This would have been intimidating to residents and passers-by. In the shop there was no alcohol on display but a large quantity of beer, wine and spirits was found in the storeroom. Photos were taken and these have been exhibited. Again the owner was spoken to and he claimed not to know that he was not allowed to keep in it in the storeroom despite having received a letter from Merton Council explaining the terms of the suspension.

There is a high rate of alcohol related anti social behaviour and crime in the area which is exacerbated by the fact people can obtain alcohol from local shops without consideration given to the licensing objectives.

Unlicensed sale of alcohol -

On 6th November 2015 a plain clothes officer was deployed to the premises and was able to purchase four (4) cans of Kronenbourg 1664 (abv 5.5%) at 2335hrs. Their licence hours for the sale of alcohol is until 2300hrs.

There is a high rate of alcohol related anti social behaviour and crime in the area which is exacerbated by the fact people can purchase alcohol from shops after licensed hours.

There are groups in the community who take advantage of this and contribute to the ASB/crime.
