

Licensing Sub-Committee Report

Subject of hearing: **Sleeico Ltd, 288 London Road, Mitcham, CR4 3NB**

1. Special Policy Area (premises licences and club certificates)

1.1 The premises are in the special policy area. However, the relevant section of Merton's Licensing Policy is not relevant to this application though the sub-committee is to have regard to the policy as a whole.

2. Type of hearing and powers of the sub-committee

2.1 The sub-committee is required to determine the application by taking such of the steps set out below as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

2.2 In making their determination the sub-committee must have regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the licensing objectives, guidance issued by the Secretary of State and Merton's Licensing Policy.

2.3 Review of premises licence: s52

- (i) To modify the conditions of the licence
- (ii) To exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
- (iii) To remove the designated premises supervisor
- (iv) To suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
- (v) To revoke the licence.
- (vi) To grant or reject the application.

3. Hearing papers

3.1 The applications, notices and representations for determination by the sub-committee are contained in the hearing bundle (attached) together with any relevant existing licence. This includes any documents which must be sent to any of the parties to the hearing under Regulation 7(2) and Schedule 3 of The Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005. This bundle has been issued to all parties to the hearing and forms part of this report.

4. Legal advice to the sub-committee

4.1 A legal officer appointed by the South London Legal Partnership will attend the hearing to advise the sub-committee on statutory provision and legal matters.

5. Licensing Officer comments

5.1 The application for a review of the premises licence, brought by the Metropolitan Police, was received by the Licensing Authority on 11th September 2017.

5.2 The review is on the grounds of all four of the Licensing Objectives.

5.3 Notices advertising the review were placed near the premises and were displayed during the 28 day consultation period.

- 5.4 The review application states that documents which include photographs, a warning letter and statements from HMRC, a Police Officer and local residents are attached to the application. We have been informed by the Police that these are to follow and will be submitted as additional information before the Sub-committee hearing as information is still being collated. It had not been received at the time this report was written.
- 5.5 We have received three supporting representations from Responsible Authorities.
- 5.6 There has been no contact from the Premises Licence Holder and we are not aware of any discussions between the Licence Holder and any other party.
