TENNIS ENFORCEMENT

For years the Labour administration has failed to properly enforce the pay to play system for the use of council owned tennis courts. The failure to properly enforce the pay to play policy has not only led to residents viewing the courts as free to use, but has led to the administrations recent attempts to enforce a level of payment that outstrips many local private tennis courts.

Council therefore requests Cabinet to:

- Provide use of all LBM owned courts for free for 12 months to enable the administration to establish an efficient system to enforce the charging of pay to play tennis;
- Instruct Merton Council Officers to prepare a report on establishing an annual pass scheme, similar to ones already operating successfully in other London boroughs, with a view to introducing a similar scheme in Merton in 12 months' time.
