

LIBERAL DEMOCRATS AMENDMENT 4 TO THE BUSINESS PLAN:

To be moved by Cllr Iain Dysart and seconded by Cllr Mary-Jane Jeanes

Introduce a new £ 2m Merton Wellbeing Innovation Fund in 2014/15 ; a fund to promote social innovation by developing new approaches to help people improve their health and wellbeing; and reducing isolation through promoting independence. Also, work with health partners and Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG's) to increase this fund. £ 2m to be transferred from General Fund reserves, which would still leave the latter above minimum prudent recommended levels ("General Fund Balances and Reserves", page 335) into earmarked reserves.
