

## UKIP AMENDMENT TO THE BUSINESS PLAN –

*To be moved by Cllr Richard Hilton and seconded by Cllr Rod Scott*

An amendment to the Budget is proposed for a one-off Council Tax rebate of £70 to the 75,000 eligible households.

It is proposed that this one-off cost of £5.250m would be funded by using the current underspend in 2013/14 of £1.070m, with the remaining £4.180m to be funded from General Fund balances, which would leave £14.658m. This is still over and above the recommended amount of 5% prudent reserve as referred to in Section 2, paragraph 7.2 Page 335 of the report.
