



**Notice is hereby given that a key decision will be taken by Cabinet on 10 November 2014, on the following matter**

**CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF A SUPPORTED LIVING SERVICE FOR ADULTS WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES**

Where a key decision contains exempt information and would be considered in private session a 28 days notice period, prior to the date of that the decision is required. If this notice period has not been given, then the decision can still be taken by the Cabinet, if the provision contained within Rule 17 (Exempt Urgency Procedure) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules Part 4B of the Constitution has been sought.

Councillor Southgate in his capacity as Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Commission has approved the use, of Section 17 - Exempt Urgency procedures for this decision.

The decision to be taken relates to the award of a new contract for the provision of a supported living service for adults with learning disabilities. The reason for urgency is to enable continuity during the implementation of the new contact. The reasons for exemption pertains to Section 10.4, Category 3 information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information), of the Access to Information Procedure Rules Part 4B of the Constitution.

It should be noted that the item had been advertised for over 28 days, but originally without the private session notice included.
