Should the Committee Members feel - in spite of overwhelming evidence for withdrawal of licence - that this venue may continue operation, herewith our requirements for amendments to the PoNaNa licence:

Sale of Alcohol:

Sunday-Thursday: 10:00 - 00:00 Friday-Saturday 10 am - 1:00

Opening Times:

Sunday-Thursday 10:00 - 00:30 Friday-Saturday 10 - :1:30

Following are conditions we believe must be added to the above licence: (It is disappointing to see so few licence conditions exist at present, and we believe at the venue must abide by similar conditions to other late night clubs in WTC)

Restrict entry to 21 and over; the 18-20 year old age group have proven tremendously irresponsible, too many 'young' drinkers, who have proven unable to abide by reasonable social convention

Sound levels to be controlled, similar to other WTC venues (identify max decibel levels)

Rear door closed and locked; rear windows not to be opened

Occurrence Book to be maintained for police/public health officer inspection

Door Supervisiors (SIA registered) at front entrance/exit and one on Kings Road (to monitor and deter antisocial behaviour)

Litter pick/vomit removal by water/disinfectant within 50 m of venue (north and south) NIGHTLY after closing

CCTV:

- Maintain good quality recorded tapes, changed daily
- Suppy tapes monthly to Police and local residents associations for monitor/review (1 year probationary period); to be re-considered following probationary period. Police unable to devote time to monitor; locals can be trained to identify concerns revealed on CCTV
